It is also safe. Your information will never be used in such away that identifies you or your household. Not even the president, law enforcement, Immigration, or housing authorities can obtain your personal data. It is important. Based on your answers, the federal government will decide how to divided 400 billion dollars and how to apportion seats in congress. It is the law. The Census Bureau must turn in the compiled data to the President by December, 2010.
