

## APARTMENT RENT AND VACANCY SURVEY BELOW MARKET RATE ADDENDUM

Results of the 2016 Apartment Rent and Vacancy Survey can be analyzed for below market rate housing. 826 below market rate apartment rental units were surveyed. 359 senior-only below market rate apartment units are not included in this survey, however, comparisons are made between non-senior only below market rate units and senior-only below market rate units at the end of this addendum. 66 new non-senior only, below market rate apartment rental units were added to the housing stock since the 2015 survey.

Of the 826 below market rate non-senior only rental apartment units included in this survey, 781 responded to the survey. Of the 781 units that reported, 13 were reported to be vacant and available for rent and 5 were reported to be vacant but unavailable for renting. The 5 unavailable units are not included in the vacancy rate.

### Vacancy:

- The overall below market rate vacancy rate is 1.7%.
- The vacancy rate for one-bedroom units is 0.9%.
- The vacancy rate for two-bedroom units is 2.2%.
- The vacancy rate for three-bedroom units is 0%.
- The vacancy rate for four-bedroom units is 0%.

- The median rent for one-bedroom below market rate units is \$730.
- The median rent for two-bedroom below market rate units is \$812.
- The median rent for three-bedroom below market rate units is \$1,047.
- The median rent for four-bedroom below market rate units is \$1,050.

Median rents for one-bedroom units vary by \$795, two-bedroom units vary by \$893, three-bedroom units vary by \$748.

Below market rate median rents for non-senior only units compared to below market rate median rents for senior-only units is reflected on the chart below.

Median rents for one-bedroom units vary by \$128 and two-bedroom unit rents vary by \$218, with senior-only below market median rents being higher than non-senior only below market median rents for each unit size.

Below market rate non-senior only vacancy rates compared to vacancy rates for senior-only below market rate units is reflected on the chart below.

Despite rents being higher for below market rate senior units, the vacancy rate for one-bedroom and two-bedroom units is lower for senior-only below market rate units compared to non-senior only below market rate units.
