The City of Vacaville Community Services Commission is recruiting members to serve on the Arts Advisory Committee to provide advice and expertise on arts related matters as requested by City Staff and/or the Community Services Commission (“Commission”), including making arts policy recommendations to the Community Services Commission and advising on larger arts issues such as long-term goals and objectives.

The Arts Advisory Committee (“Committee”) shall consist of five members who are not City employees or members of the City Council and who shall serve at the pleasure of the Community Services Commission. It will be a goal of the Community Services Commission to appoint members who represent a diverse cross section of the arts, including one member with expertise in visual arts, one member with expertise in performing arts, and one member with expertise in arts education.

### **Qualifications**

Preferably, Arts Advisory Committee members shall be artists, designers, gallery owners, landscape architects, arts educators, arts administrators, architects or planners or persons who are specially qualified by reason of training, experience, interest or involvement in the arts particularly as related to artistic activities in the City of Vacaville. Members shall be, at the time of appointment and throughout their term of appointment, residents of the City of Vacaville.

### **Appointments**

The Community Services Commission will appoint all members of the Arts Advisory Committee. Prior to final approval the mayor will review all appointments. An ad-hoc sub-committee of the Community Services Commission will conduct interviews of qualified applicants. The sub-committee will make member recommendations to the full Commission.
