POLICE SEEK SUSPECTS IN THURSDAY EVENING SHOOTING

Vacaville police are seeking two men who shot at a man while he was driving down Brown Street Thursday evening.

Vacaville police officers were dispatched to the intersection of E. Monte Vista Avenue and Brown Street at about 9 p.m. following calls of numerous gunshots in the area.

Upon arrival, officers located an adult male victim who said he had been shot at by two unknown males in the 300 block of Brown Street. During the course of the investigation, officers located four (4) bullet holes in the victim's car - two in the windshield, and two in the drivers' side door. The victim was not injured in the assault.

The victim told officers that he was driving northbound near the 300 block of Brown Street. He briefly saw two persons near the west side of the street on the sidewalk. At one point, one of the subjects produced a firearm and shot at the victim. The victim then fled the area at a high rate of speed.

The suspects are still outstanding and were last seen running northbound on Brown Street. The suspects are described as males, 18-25 years old, wearing dark colored clothing.
