Monument Signs - Per California Building Code Section 107.2.5 and Uniform Sign Code Section 302, all monument sign permit applicants are required to submit a site plan showing the location of all right of way lines, property lines, easements, light poles, fences, fire hydrants or any other fixed object on the site within 20 feet in every direction of the proposed sign. The plot plan shall show or state the monument used for horizontal staking control. Staking control lines indicating bearing and distance from the horizontal control to the sign shall be shown on the plans.

The plot plan may be of any size not exceeding 24x36 inches and not less than 8-1/2 x 11 inches.

The plan review shall include but not be limited to ensuring the sign is on the property of the permit application address, ensuring the sign is not within any easements, ensuring the sign is not in the public right of way, ensuring the sign is out of any site distance triangle as defined in the Public Works Standard Specifications, latest edition.
