### **POLICE ARREST THREE SUSPECTS IN RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

Thanks to the actions of an alert resident, police arrested three people believed to be involved in a home burglary that had taken place early Wednesday morning.

At about 12:07 a.m. Wednesday morning, officers were dispatched to a house in the 300 block of Chelan Drive for a possible burglary in progress. A witness reported seeing two males who did not live at the home entering the garage from the side yard.

The suspects were seen putting property into a vehicle, described as a dark-colored minivan that was parked in front of the house. The van was last seen on Chelan Drive heading toward Shasta Drive.

An officer spotted a vehicle matching that description and stopped it in the 200 block Shasta Drive. During a search of the vehicle, which was occupied by three people, the officer located several items of suspected stolen property. It was determined the garage of the victim's house had been entered and property had been taken. The victim was not home at the time of the burglary. The witness identified the vehicle and occupants as being involved in the burglary.

Police arrested S-Anthony Aispuro, 26, of Vacaville; S-Christina Buckshot, 40, of Vacaville; and a 16-year-old male juvenile. S-Aispuro was booked into Solano County Jail for residential burglary, possession of stolen property, and conspiracy to commit theft. S-Buckshot was booked into Solano County Jail for the same charges along with possession of controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. The 16-year-old male was booked into Juvenile Hall for residential burglary, and possession of stolen property.
