VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST THREE FOR AUTO THEFT

Three people were arrested Saturday evening thanks to alert residents contacting police about suspicious activity in their neighborhood.

On Saturday, October 20, 2012 at approximately 7:11 p.m., officers were investigating an interrupted auto burglary in the 100 block of Nut Tree Parkway after a witness to the crime noted the suspicious behavior and called the police.

The suspects fled, but officers were circulating in the area looking for the suspects and a van seen fleeing the area. A short time later, an officer saw a similar van with subjects fitting the description of those involved in the crime fleeing west on I-80. Officers stopped the van near the Pena Adobe exit and detained the subjects.

A subsequent probation search resulted in the recovery of a stolen car stereo taken from a stolen vehicle. Police arrested S-Valentino Lopez, 20, of West Sacramento; S-Alfonso Martinez, 35, of Sacramento; and S-Andrew Pinzon, 26, a transient on a variety of charges, including probation violation, possessing stolen property, and conspiracy. All three were booked into Solano County Jail without incident.
