UPDATED PRESS RELEASE FOR HOME INVASION ROBBERY

VACAVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT MAKES ARREST IN OCTOBER 12 HOME INVASION ROBBERY

On Tuesday, October 30, 2012, Vacaville police Tuesday arrested a man connected to a home invasion robbery that took place October 12, 2012.

At approximately 2:37 p.m. Tuesday, the Vacaville Police Department SWAT Team served a search warrant in the 700 block of Beythe Lane. Three adult males and one small child were contacted during the service of the warrant and detained. Several Pit Bull dogs were also found on the property and restrained by Humane Animal Services.

The warrant was in connection to a home invasion robbery investigation from earlier this month in the 100 block of Skyview Place. Several items of evidence were seized during the warrant service, including a handgun. S-Jihad Malcolm Osby, 18, of Vacaville was taken into custody at the home and later booked into Solano County Jail on a variety of charges. The investigation is ongoing and additional suspects are being sought.

POLICE SEEK TWO SUSPECTS IN EARLY-MORNING HOME BREAK-IN

Police are looking for two men who entered a home on Skyview Drive early Friday morning and assaulted one of the residents before taking items and leaving.

On Friday morning at about 12:44 a.m., the police communications center received a call of a disturbance in the 100 block of Skyview Place. Upon arrival, officers contacted the homeowners, who told officers that two suspects had forced entry into the residence through a rear sliding door.

At the time of entry, both homeowners and their two small children were sleeping in the residence. The homeowners were awakened by the noise, at which time the male homeowner confronted the suspects, who immediately began assaulting him. At one point, one of the suspects pointed a gun at both homeowners.

At that point the suspects realized that one of the homeowners had managed to call police, and they left the residence, stealing miscellaneous property. Police established a perimeter around the home, and utilizing the assistance of a California Highway Patrol helicopter, searched the area, but the suspects were not located.

The suspects are described as two black male adults, one about 6' 4" with a heavy build, the other about 6' 0" with a thin build. Anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to contact Officer Mike Miller at 707-449-5200.
