FINGERPRINT MATCH LEADS TO ARREST IN JULY HOME BURGLARY

Police arrested a Vacaville man for a home burglary that took place last summer when a fingerprint found at the crime scene led them to the suspect.

Last July 2012, Vacaville police investigated a residential burglary that occurred in the 800 block of Turquoise Drive in which the suspects forced their way into the house and stole several items. The investigating officer located several latent fingerprints at the scene that were later sent to Department of Justice for identification.

In late November 2012, police were notified that a match had been made through the Automated Latent Print System. The victims did not know the person who had been identified and he had never been to their house.

On December 4, 2012 at 8:00 a.m., patrol officers and detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) served a search warrant at a house in the 500 block of Klamath Drive and detained two people. Officers located property that matched the description of property taken during the burglary. S-Robert Miller, the man identified by the fingerprint search, was arrested and booked into Solano County Jail for residential burglary.
