### **CHASE ENDS WITH SUSPECTS IN OUTLET THEFTS ARRESTED**

Vacaville police arrested two women Thursday who had stolen items from a retail outlet store.

Police were called to the Vacaville Premium Outlets in the 300 block of Nut Tree Road Thursday afternoon regarding a group of females who had just stolen approximately \$750 worth of merchandise from one of the stores. Employees and witnesses were able to provide 9-1-1 dispatchers with a description of the three suspects, of the vehicle that was used, an Audi, and a license plate number for the vehicle.

Officers conducting an area check for the Audi and located it traveling west on I-80. A stop was attempted but the vehicle continued for approximately one mile before pulling over.

Employees who witnessed the theft were taken to where the suspect Audi was stopped. S-Jessica Love, 26, of El Sobrante and S-Monique Erwin, 26, of Oakland were positively identified as having taken merchandise from the business without paying.

Officers searched the Audi and found the stolen property from the reported theft along with a device used to remove anti-theft tags.

Additional merchandise was found that came from nine different stores. No receipts or bags for any of the stores were located. One of the stores was contacted and confirmed the property was missing from the store. Officers are continuing to follow up with the other eight stores.

S-Love was arrested for burglary and driving on a suspended driver's license. S-Erwin was arrested for burglary. Both were booked into the Solano County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department appreciates the alert employees and witnesses who called the police department with descriptions of the suspects, their vehicle, and the license plate number. Without this information this case may not have been solved.
