POLICE SEEK WITNESSES TO HIT-AND-RUN ON LEISURE TOWN ROAD

Vacaville police are asking anyone who may have witnessed a multi-car accident on Leisure Town Road to contact them as soon as possible.

On Wednesday afternoon at approximately 2:07 p.m., officers responded to a traffic collision on Leisure Town Road just south of Ulatis Drive. Officers arrived on scene and found three cars involved in the collision, but those involved told officers that a fourth vehicle had caused the accident and fled the scene.

Witnesses told officers that a Toyota Sienna was traveling southbound on Leisure Town Road just south of Ulatis Drive, while a Toyota Camry was traveling behind the Sienna. The Camry was struck from behind by an unknown vehicle, which pushed the Camry into the Sienna.

After being struck, the Camry rotated 360 degrees, crossed over into the northbound lane and collided with a Jeep Wrangler head-on in the northbound lane. The Sienna left the roadway and collided with the sound wall on the west side of the roadway on Leisure Town Road. The vehicle that caused the collision fled the scene in an unknown direction. The driver and passenger of the Toyota Camry were taken to a local hospital and treated for complaint of pain. The drivers of the Sienna and Jeep were not injured.

A portion of Leisure Town Road between Ulatis Drive and Zephyr Lane was closed for an hour while officers investigated the collision and cleared the roadway.

Evidence at the scene indicates that a fourth vehicle was involved and caused this collision. The Vacaville Police Department is asking anyone who may have witnessed this traffic collision to call Officer Rod Neal at 707-449-5200.
