TWO JUVENILES ARRESTED FOLLOWING STRONGARM ROBBERY

A robbery and assault in Andrews Park ended with two juvenile suspects being arrested Tuesday evening with a third suspect still at large.

At around 7:53 p.m., officers responded to the park after two adult males were accosted by several Hispanic males. One of the suspects asked one of the victims a question. Before the victim could respond, the suspects began assaulting the two men, taking their bicycles, a cell phone and a watch.

Shortly thereafter, an officer located three subjects in front of the Lucky grocery store on E. Monte Vista Avenue. Upon seeing the officers, the three men fled. The officer gave chase, immediately catching one of the suspects. A short time later, another suspect was apprehended by the officer as he exited the grocery store carrying an 18-pack of beer. Upon further investigation, officers determined the beer had been stolen.

One of the stolen bikes was located near the Georgie Duke Sports Center, along with more beer that had been taken from another market.

The victims of the assault and robbery were able to positively identify the two suspects as having participated in the assault and robbery. One of the suspects was also in possession of the stolen cell phone.

The suspects were intoxicated and both had outstanding warrants for their arrests on other charges. They both were on probation and were reported runaways out of Solano County. Both juveniles were booked into Juvenile Hall for strong armed robbery, commercial burglary, probation violation, and other charges.

The third suspect, who was not located, is described as a 16-to-18-year-old Hispanic male and was last seen running northbound on Markham Avenue. He was wearing a dark, hooded sweatshirt and a white beanie cap.
