Pursuit Ends in Collision - Two in Custody

On Tuesday, April 16, 2013 at 3:56 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Bantry Dr for a disturbance. The reporting party provided dispatch with a license plate of a vehicle associated with the call. The vehicle came back reported stolen out of the Rocklin. An officer spotted the vehicle on Allison Drive near Ulatis Drive. A pursuit ensued and the vehicle fled eastbound on Elmira Road and pulled into the apartment complex at 555 Elmira Road. The vehicle proceeded to the rear of the apartments and crashed into a tree.

The driver, later identified as 22 year old, Woodland Resident, (Parolee at Large) Randy Gilbertson fled the vehicle on foot and was seen running north along the Putah Creek Canal. A perimeter was set-up and he was located hiding in a backyard in the 300 block of Saybrook Circle. He was taken into custody after a brief struggle. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment of injuries he sustained from the collision and during the foot pursuit. The passenger in the vehicle was identified as 18 year old Rocklin resident, S-Danielle Foster. She had been named as the suspect in the original vehicle theft report. She is on probation for petty theft. She suffered a leg injury during the collision and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. She was admitted over night for her injury.

A complaint will be filed against her charging her with vehicle theft and probation violation. S-Gilbertson was released from the hospital and booked into Solano County Jail. He was charged with Vehicle Theft, Evading Police Causing Injuries, Parole Violation, and a Yolo County warrant for probation violation.
