FOUR ARRESTED AFTER ARMED ROBBERY IN BROWNS VALLEY AREA

Four people were arrested early Friday morning after they robbed a Vacaville man at gunpoint in the Browns Valley area.

At about 1:05 a.m. Friday morning, a Vacaville resident contacted the Vacaville Police Department to report he had been the victim of an armed robbery. The victim said he willingly got into a vehicle occupied by an acquaintance and a female driver. The victim was taken to the area of Wrentham Drive and Ballindine Drive, in the Browns Valley subdivision, where he was confronted by two subjects who were apparently acting in cohort with the subjects in the vehicle. One subject held a gun to the victim's head, while another subject removed valuables from the victim, including cash and jewelry.

The victim provided a detailed description of the vehicle the suspects were in, along with the name of the suspect he knew. Shortly thereafter, an officer spotted a possible match of the vehicle on I-80 westbound near Cherry Glen Road. The officer followed the car on westbound I-80 towards Fairfield.

Vacaville Police Department Communications Center personnel then contacted the Fairfield Police Department Communications Center and requested assistance from their agency.

Several Fairfield Police Department patrol units entered the freeway at the Travis Boulevard on-ramp and conducted a high-risk car stop on I-80 westbound at Highway 12. The California Highway Patrol temporarily shut down the westbound lanes of travel until the occupants of the vehicle were safely detained.

Evidence of the robbery, including an airsoft gun, was found in the vehicle. Five occupants of the vehicle were detained and one was later released. The other four suspects were arrested for a variety of charges including armed robbery, conspiracy, and possession of stolen property.

Benicia residents S-Kimberly Trowbridge, 38, and S-Devyn Coney-Jones, 18, along with Vallejo resident S-Montrece Howard, 22, were booked into Solano County Jail in Fairfield. A 17-year-old Benicia resident involved in the incident was booked into Juvenile Hall.
