### **ARRESTS MADE IN ROBBERY AT VACAVILLE U-HAUL RENTAL STORE**

Two people have been arrested in Gilroy in connection with an armed robbery that took place at a Vacaville U-Haul facility on Sunday evening.

Vacaville police learned that S-Joshua Davenport, a suspect in the armed robbery, and S-Jessika Davenport, his wife, were together at a Motel 6 in Gilroy, CA. Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department along with members of the Gilroy Police Department converged on the motel and began surveillance.

At one point during this surveillance, officers identified S-Joshua Davenport as he entered one of the rooms of the motel, while his wife, S-Jessika Davenport, was seen leaving the area in the couple's vehicle. Following a traffic stop a short time later, S-Jessika Davenport was taken into custody. Several children with S-Jessika Davenport were taken into protective custody.

Following a short standoff with Gilroy SWAT Team officers back at the motel, S-Joshua Davenport was taken into custody. An illegal firearm was also located in the room.

Both suspects were transported to Solano County Jail in Fairfield. S-Joshua Davenport was booked for the outstanding robbery arrest warrant, while S-Jessika Davenport was



booked for aiding and abetting a wanted fugitive. Investigators learned the couple was fleeing to the state of Texas in an attempt to evade capture.

**VACAVILLE POLICE SEEK SUSPECTS IN ROBBERY AT U-HAUL STORE**

Vacaville police are seeking three suspects in the armed robbery of a U-Haul rental store that took place Sunday evening.

At approximately 5:33 p.m., police received a 9-1-1 call of a robbery at the U-Haul Center at 1240 E. Monte Vista Avenue. Patrol officers responded to the address and secured the crime scene.

According to witnesses, three suspects entered the business, each armed with a dark-colored handgun. They forced the employees into one area of the store and held them at gunpoint and then fled the store with an undisclosed amount of cash.



S-Joshua Davenport, 34, of Suisun has been identified as one of the suspects in this case and a warrant for his arrest is being sought. S-Joshua Davenport has a long violent criminal history and is considered armed and dangerous. Witnesses said the suspects left in a tan 1999 Ford Expedition with California license plate number 4FIZ662. The vehicle is still outstanding.

Detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) are continuing the investigation. A search warrant was executed at S-Joshua Davenport's address in Suisun following this incident, but he was not located.
