POLICE SEEK THREE SUSPECTS IN ARMED ROBBERY BEHIND WINCO Description of suspects match those of suspects in previous incident

Vacaville police are seeking three individuals who committed an armed robbery Monday, January 20, 2014, that they believe may be involved in an earlier incident that took place in downtown Vacaville last week.

Early Monday morning at approximately 12:18 a.m., officers responded to the bike path behind WinCo Foods on Davis Street for a reported armed robbery.

Responding officers learned that six victims had been walking home on the path when they were confronted by three individuals described as two Hispanic males and one Hispanic female between the ages of 18 and 22 years old. One of the suspects, armed with a black handgun, demanded their wallets and cell phones.

The suspects took money out of the victims' wallets and then returned the wallets; they also took the victims' cell phones, preventing them from calling the police department immediately.

The suspects were last seen running through the parking lot of WinCo toward Davis Street. The descriptions of the suspects in this case are similar to those involved in a robbery that occurred January 15, 2014 in a parking area behind a business in the 500 block of Main Street.
