### **Residential Burglary Results in Extensive Search for Suspect(s)**

On January 22, 2014 at approximately 10:54 a.m., Vacaville Police received a call from a citizen who reported seeing a male armed with a rifle in the creek near the 700 block of Linwood Street. The citizen had a short conversation with the male (suspect) before the male fled on foot northwest along the creek.

Vacaville Police Officers arrived and quickly located several rifles abandoned on the north side of the creek. At this time Vacaville Police did not have a reported burglary in the area. Based on this information, a large perimeter was established. A CHP airplane and a Vacaville Police Canine were requested and assisted in the search. Because it was unknown if the suspect(s) were armed and an active search was being conducted, the Vacaville Police requested Willis Jepson Middle School be placed on lockdown for student and staff security.

While the search was taking place detectives were able to identify a residence in the 700 block of Linwood Street that was burglarized. The residents were contacted and they responded to the residence to assist with an inventory of the residence.

After approximately two hours of searching for the suspect(s), the search was terminated and Willis Jepson Middle School was taken off lockdown status.
