VACAVILLE OFFICERS RECOGNIZED FOR DUI REDUCTION EFFORTS

Three Vacaville police officers were recognized on Monday for their efforts to reduce the impact of those who are driving under the influence at the annual California Office of Traffic Safety and Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) Law Enforcement Recognition Luncheon in Petaluma.

The officers were recognized for their total number of DUI arrests and contributions made to the field of DUI enforcement. Each year Cal OTS and MADD recognize officers from the North Bay area, which is comprised of Solano, Sonoma, Napa and Marin counties.

For the second year in a row, Officer Chuck Bailey topped all North Bay area law enforcement personnel by making a total of 122 DUI arrests. Officer Bailey has led the Vacaville Police Department in DUI arrests the past nine years in a row and is passionate about DUI enforcement, becoming a recognized expert in the field.

Also honored was Officer Danny Martinez for making a total of 31 DUI arrests, while Officer Chad Hudson received special recognition from the Solano County DUI task force "AVOID the 10" for his continued commitment and support of this program.

"As these officers' supervisor, I am truly proud of their efforts to remove these dangerous drivers from Vacaville's roadways to keep our citizens safe," said Sgt. Mark Donaldson. "DUI is a 100 percent preventable crime yet sadly, as you can see, many chose to still get behind the wheel and drive impaired."
