### **Narrative:**

On June 15, 2014 at 6:36 p.m., Officers from the Vacaville Police Department were dispatched to the Michael Kors Outlet for a theft in progress. A store clerk reported a dark skinned Hispanic or Indian male in his late twenties had grabbed clothing items from within the store and fled without paying. The suspect broke the front glass door when his shoulder struck it upon exiting. The male entered the backseat of a waiting 4-door white Mercedes Benz with unknown paper plates and tinted windows. The suspect was described as wearing a baseball hat, shorts and a navy blue shirt with yellow sleeves. The vehicle was last seen traveling through the parking lot.

Officers arrived on scene and began searching for the suspect vehicle. At approximately 6:47 p.m., a Vacaville Police Department Officer observed a 4-door white Mercedes Benz with tinted windows and paper plates on I-80 westbound just passing Mason Street. The vehicle was being driven by a dark skinned Hispanic or Indian male in his twenties with short dark hair. There was a Hispanic or Indian female in the right front passenger seat. She was also in her twenties and had long black hair.

The officer attempted a car stop believing this was the vehicle associated with the theft. Traffic in the area was heavy at the time. As the officer activated his emergency lights and siren, the vehicle began to yield to the right shoulder. As it made its way to the shoulder, the vehicle then accelerated at a high rate of speed and continued driving dangerously on the shoulder. A short pursuit ensued but was ultimately cancelled due to public safety concerns. The suspect and vehicle were last seen on I-80 westbound passing Pena Adobe Road.
