### **SEARCH FOR ROBBERY SUSPECTS NETS TWO ON UNRELATED CHARGES**

A search for three suspects in a strong armed robbery resulted in Vacaville police arresting two men on a variety of charges unrelated to the earlier crime.

At around 2:32 p.m. Tuesday, police responded to Keating Park for a strong armed robbery that had just occurred. The female victim had her purse and cell phone taken by force by two black males and one white male. The suspects were described as being 20 to 30 years old and were last seen running from California Drive and onto Mariposa Drive.

Officers arrived on scene and began a search for the suspects. An officer located two black male adults in their 20s at a nearby apartment complex parking lot in the 1500 block of Alamo Drive. One of the suspects, Dezmon Frazier, 21, of Vacaville is well known to the Vacaville Police Department, having prior contacts and arrests. The second suspect, Armoni Wiley, 22 and also from Vacaville, is currently out on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) as part of California's prison realignment.

A pat search for weapons was conducted on S-Frazier, who was found to be carrying a concealed, fully loaded Smith & Wesson 9mm handgun with a high capacity magazine that did not return registered to him. S-Frazier was placed under arrest and additionally charged with committing a felony while out on bail.

After contact with the Solano County Probation Department, it was determined S-Armoni Wiley had not been in contact with his probation officer. They requested he be arrested for violating the terms of his Post Release Community Supervision.



Officers determined S-Frazier and S-Wiley were not involved in the original strong armed robbery. They were booked into Solano County Jail on the above listed charges. Photos of the suspects are attached.
