### **TRAFFIC COLLISION ENDS IN ARREST OF DRIVER ON DUI CHARGES**

A traffic collision early Saturday morning led to the arrest of a Vacaville man on charges he was driving under the influence.

At around 12:08 a.m. Saturday, Vacaville police and fire units responded to the 300 block of Eldridge Avenue following reports of a major traffic collision. A Chevy Silverado pickup was traveling northbound on Eldridge Avenue at a high rate of speed when it crashed into a parked car. The impact pushed the parked car off the road and into the front of a nearby residence. After the first collision, the Chevy pickup continued northbound where it collided with a parked pickup truck.

When police units arrived on scene, they contacted the driver of the pickup, S-Kevin Fertey, 28, of Vacaville and a female passenger, who had suffered minor injuries as a result of the collision. During the course of the investigation, S-Fertey was placed under arrest for suspicion of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, causing injury and driving on a suspended license. He was transported and booked into Solano County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department would like to remind residents that these collisions are avoidable and the results could have been far more tragic. We encourage citizens to designate a sober driver and to not drink and drive.
