Narrative:

On October 18, 2014 at approximately 5:14 a.m., Vacaville Police Department patrol officers responded to a report of a stabbing that had occurred in the area of the Union 76 Gas Station located at 605 Elmira Road. When officers arrived on scene, they learned a transient male had been sleeping in the area of a former bank; located at 661 Elmira Road. Three Hispanic males threw a beer bottle at him, waking him up. The suspects then fled the area on foot. A short time later, the victim was walking in the area of the Union 76 Gas Station at 605 Elmira Road when the suspects returned and surrounded him. The victim ran back to 661 Elmira Road with the suspects chasing him. The suspects again surrounded the victim, physically assaulted him, and robbed him of a small amount of cash. During the attack, the victim was stabbed twice. The suspects again fled on foot. The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Officers conducted an area check for the suspects, but were not able to locate them at that time.

At approximately 6:38 a.m., Vacaville Police Department dispatch received a report of an attempted robbery that had just occurred in the area of Nut Tree Road and Summerfield Drive, which is in close proximity to where the stabbing occurred. A second and unrelated victim indicated he had just been finishing a run and was walking in the area when a green Honda with a headlight out pulled up next to him. A Hispanic male confronted the victim and demanded



money while reaching for, what the victim believed to be a weapon, in his waistband. The victim ran away and the suspects fled in the vehicle.

Officers responded to the area and began looking for the vehicle. Officer Nichole King located a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle in the intersection of Nut Tree Road and Elmira Road. Officer King advised dispatch of the license plate on the vehicle and she was told the vehicle was stolen from an address in Vacaville on 10/17/14. Officers attempted a traffic stop on the vehicle and it fled at a high rate of speed. A short pursuit ensued and concluded when the driver of the Honda, later identified as S-Daniel Ortiz, crashed the vehicle into a tree at the entrance to the apartment complex in the 100 block of Summerfield Drive. S-Ortiz fled the vehicle on foot and was captured a short distance away. The two back seat passengers, later identified as S-Angel Alvarado and a 17 year old male (whose name is not being released), were arrested while still in the car.

During further investigation, all three suspects were determined to have been the suspects that attacked, robbed, and stabbed the transient victim. It was further determined that S-Alvarado had attempted to rob the second victim and the other two suspects assisted him in that crime.
