POLICE MAKE ARREST IN OCTOBER 3rd SHOOTING INCIDENT

Vacaville police have made an arrest in the shooting into a home that took place on Novato Drive on October 3rd.

A resident in the home had called 9-1-1 to report someone had shot into the residence, narrowly missing some of the occupants (original press release is below). Through the course of this investigation, the Vacaville Police Department Crime Suppression Team (CST) and the Investigative Services Section (ISS) were able to identify S-Adrian Garcia, 20, of Vacaville as a suspect in this shooting.

On October 28, 2014 the Crime Suppression Team Detectives located S-Garcia at his place of employment in the 900 block of Aldridge Road in Vacaville. S-Garcia was arrested and booked in Solano County Jail for Attempted Murder (664/187 PC) and Assault with a Deadly Weapon-Firearm (245(a)(2)PC).

VACAVILLE POLICE SEEK SUSPECT IN SHOOTING INTO HOME

Vacaville police are looking for a man who shot into a home on Novato Drive Friday evening.

Police received a 9-1-1 call from a resident saying someone had just shot at their house. The suspect who fired the shots then fled the scene on foot.

People inside the home, as well as in front of the home, narrowly missed being struck by bullets. Investigating officers responded to the scene and located a bullet hole in an occupied bedroom.

Detectives from the Crime Suppression Team (CST) and Investigative Services Section (ISS) responded to provide assistance and investigative support. The case is currently under active investigation.

The suspect described as a Hispanic male in his late teens with light-colored shoulder length hair.
