POLICE ARREST TWO WITH STOLEN CELL TOWER PROPERTY

Vacaville police arrested two people on burglary charges Monday morning after an alert officer noticed their vehicle parked in a suspicious manner behind a building on Vaca Valley Parkway.

Around 7 a.m. Monday, an officer noticed a suspicious vehicle parked behind a cellular telephone tower distribution building located in the 700 block of Vaca Valley Parkway. The vehicle, a truck, was parked in a manner to hide its location. The access gate to the tower building, as well as the fenced area around the building, were unlocked but closed to make it appear they were still locked.

Upon further investigation, officers determined the suspects were still inside the building, which had been broken into by force. At that point, officers contacted S-Jason Hamilton, 33, of Forest Hill and S-Katie Wade, 26, of Suisun City inside the building and found numerous burglary tools in their possession as well as stolen items from the building.

Further investigation found numerous large batteries inside the truck the suspects had been driving. It appears the suspects were attempting to steal the batteries from this building when they were contacted by police.

Both suspects were arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail on numerous charges. This case is still being investigated as it may be related to other similar cell phone tower thefts.
