TWO VACAVILLE RESIDENTS ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

Vacaville police arrested a local man and a juvenile following an attempted robbery of a juvenile on Saturday afternoon.

Officers responded to the 100 block of Aegean Way for a report of two subjects who allegedly tried to rob a juvenile at knifepoint, were allegedly flashing gang signs and allegedly brandishing a handgun at a people in a passing SUV in a threatening manner. Officers arrived on scene and saw two subjects matching the description of the suspects. The suspects saw the officer and ran north of Aegean Way toward the Chaparral Loop area of north Vacaville.

Officers set up a perimeter and began a search for the suspects, eventually locating one suspect hiding in debris to the rear of a business on Aegean Way. Officers located a knife and other evidence believed to be used in the attempted robbery.

Officers located the second suspect, a 16-year-old juvenile, hiding in a yard between two homes in the 500 block of Chaparral Loop. The suspect refused to submit to arrest and ran from officers, and was later taken into custody by police K-9 Roscoe. During the arrest, the suspect was bitten on the leg by Roscoe. The juvenile was taken to the Vaca Valley Hospital Emergency Room where he was medically cleared as a result of a dog bite to his leg. The suspects were both on probation with gang terms and are known to police.

S-Daniel Martinez, 18, was booked into the Solano County Jail, while the juvenile was booked into Solano County Juvenile Hall.

The Vacaville Police Department would like to thank the community members that assisted police with the search for these dangerous suspects. This case is still under active investigation.
