### **JARRETT BUSH DETAINED, RELEASED FOLLOWING INCIDENT AT RESTAURANT, BAR**

A pro football player and Vacaville resident was detained and later released following an incident at a restaurant and bar in Downtown Vacaville.

Vacaville police received a call early Sunday morning of a large fight in front of Evelyn's Big Italian Restaurant, located in Downtown Vacaville. Police responded and found a large gathering of people outside the restaurant. Upon arrival of the police, most of the crowd was quickly dispersed without incident.

A few people did remain, and were repeatedly asked to leave the area. One person in particular refused to leave and continued to create a disturbance, and as a result he was taken into custody and charged with public intoxication.

After his arrest, officers learned the identity of the man was Jarrett Bush, 30, a Vacaville resident and a professional football player with the Green Bay Packers. Bush was cooperative with officers after being detained and was transported to Solano County Jail in Fairfield, CA. No charges will be filed against Bush, who was released a short time later per 849b, which is listed below:

849. (b) Any peace officer may release from custody, instead of taking such person before a magistrate, any person arrested without a warrant whenever:

- (1) He or she is satisfied that there are insufficient grounds for making a criminal complaint against the person arrested.
  - (2) The person arrested was arrested for intoxication only, and no further proceedings are desirable.
  - (3) The person was arrested only for being under the influence of a controlled substance or drug and such person is delivered to a facility or hospital for treatment and no further proceedings are desirable.
- (c) Any record of arrest of a person released pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (3) of subdivision (b) shall include a record of release. Thereafter, such arrest shall not be deemed an arrest, but a detention only.
