VACAVILLE PAROLEE ARRESTED FOR EVADING POLICE, OTHER CHARGES

A parolee was arrested Saturday night after a short high-speed pursuit at speeds of up to 90 mph.

A Vacaville police officer made a traffic enforcement stop in the 1400 block of East Monte Vista Avenue at about 10:07 p.m Saturday night. As the officer approached the car the driver sped away. The car fled west onto Monte Vista Avenue at a high speed before turning north on to Allison Drive. The driver threw items from the car while fleeing at approximately 90 mph.

The driver lost control of the car after a short pursuit near the intersection of Allison Drive and Browns Valley Parkway. The car struck the north curblin, disabling the car, fled on foot and was arrested a short distance away. Police arrested the driver, Ryan Francis Caligiuri, 25, of Vacaville - the only occupant of the car.

Officers recovered ammunition on Caligiuri, who is on active parole and a convicted felon. He is prohibited from owning or possessing ammunition or firearms.

Officers conducted an article search with two police K-9 teams along the pursuit route. The K-9 teams located a .38 caliber revolver and a loaded .44 Magnum revolver that had been discarded by Caligiuri. Caligiuri was booked into the Solano County Jail without further incident. There was no other property damage and no injuries.
