TRIO ARRESTED ON A VARIETY OF CHARGES, INCLUDING DUI AND WARRANTS

Three Vacaville residents were arrested Sunday evening on a variety of charges, including DUI, resisting arrest and outstanding warrants.

On August 16, 2015 at about 7:30 p.m., officers responded to the 100 block of Gable Avenue for a report of vandalism to a window. The victim told officers two suspects approached his apartment with a handgun. One of the suspects broke the apartment window out by hitting it with the handgun. The suspects then left the area and officers were provided a description of the suspects and their vehicle.

Approximately twenty minutes later an officer recognized the suspect vehicle driving in the area of Markham and Rocky Hill. Officers conducted a high risk stop on the car on Rocky Hill near Gable based on the information they may be armed with a handgun.

During the car stop both suspects were uncooperative when given directions by officers. The passenger of the vehicle, Joshua Jimenez, 32, of Vacaville eventually complied and was taken into custody. He provided a false name to officers and was found to be too intoxicated to care for himself.

Joshua Jimenez was arrested on resisting arrest, false identification, public intoxication, probation violation and a felony no bail probation violation warrant related to a vandalism charges.

The driver of the vehicle, Anthony Jimenez, 33, of Vacaville refused to exit the vehicle and continued to refuse directions from officers. Due to safety concerns to the public and the officers, a police K9 unit was deployed to take the driver into custody. The driver continued to fight the police K9 and officers as they attempted to arrest him. He was finally controlled with an Electronic Control Device (Taser).

Anthony Jimenez was transported to Vaca Valley Hospital for medical treatment from injuries sustained while being apprehended by the K9. After being medically cleared he was booked into Solano County Jail on DUI, resisting arrest and probation violation charges.

During the high risk vehicle stop a female relative of the two suspects attempted to interfere. Isabel Jimenez, 30, of Vacaville was arrested for obstructing a police investigation.

All three suspects were booked into Solano County Jail.
