POLICE ARREST MAN EARLY SUNDAY MORNING FOR DISCHARGING FIREARM

Vacaville police arrested a Garden Grove man early Sunday morning after he fired several rounds from a handgun in downtown Vacaville during a dispute.

Officers were flagged down on Sunday morning just prior to 2 a.m. by witnesses who had seen a man fire off numerous shots in the parking lot behind a local bar in the 500 block of Main Street. Witnesses provided a description of the subjects and the vehicle they fled in and officers began to circulate in the area. Officers located a vehicle matching the description given by witnesses parked in the parking lot of a local hotel and could see a handgun underneath the passenger seat of the vehicle.

Officers waited to see if the occupants would return to the vehicle and a short time later one of the occupants, Anthony Pech, 20, of Garden Grove returned to the vehicle at which time officers attempted to talk with him.

Pech ran from officers back into the hotel. Officers chased him through the hotel, up to the third floor and back down and out a back door. As Pech exited out the back door he was contacted by another officer who ordered him to stop.

Pech refused numerous orders to stop, and a less than lethal flexible baton round – also known as a Bean Bag Round – was deployed, striking Pech and disabling him. He was immediately taken into custody.

Officers learned Pech was involved in a verbal altercation behind the bar at which time the handgun was discharged into the air.
