### **DISTURBANCE LEADS TO ARREST OF MAN IN SHOOTING INCIDENT**

A disturbance call in one part of a neighborhood led to the arrest of a man who allegedly shot another man on a nearby street Sunday morning.

At about 9:38 a.m. on December 13 officers responded to the 200 block of Troon Court for a disturbance call of a person banging on the front door of the caller's house.

While officers were on their way to this call, a second caller reported seeing a male walking down the street in the 100 block of Pebble Beach Circle with a gun in his hand, and a short time later the caller heard a gunshot.

Officers arrived in the area and located a male sitting in a vehicle with a single gunshot wound to the leg. Paramedics were called to scene and the victim was transported to a local hospital with a non-life threatening injury.

Detectives were called out to assist with this investigation and detained two people from an address in the 200 block of Troon Court. Detectives later determined that Dulon Stevens, 41, of Vacaville was involved in this shooting. He was arrested and booked into Solano County Jail for assault with a deadly weapon.

Detectives obtained a search warrant for Stevens' residence and located a handgun believed to have been used in the shooting.
